This year's goal for the school is to enhance the learning experience for young children. We believe outdoor experiential learning is crucial for their growth. Therefore, we will lead students from various classes in diverse outdoor activities. Lower and upper kindergarten children will visit places like libraries, ocean parks, and traffic safety education centers, while preparatory and nursery students will explore nearby parks. These activities will improve their observational skills, stimulate curiosity, and allow for enjoyable picnics, where they will learn about cleanliness and environmental protection, fostering a better understanding of their community.

Additionally, the school will promote home-school cooperation to strengthen relationships between parents and children and improve communication among parents. We plan to organize parent lectures, workshops, competitions, and family fun days to enhance interaction between the school and families. To bolster teachers' professional development, the school will arrange various training programs, enabling them to continue their education and integrate new knowledge into their teaching. This year, teachers will also have the opportunity to engage with different teaching philosophies and methods through exchanges in mainland China.

We look forward to these initiatives improving the quality of education in our kindergarten, providing young children with an enriched learning experience, and supporting their joyful growth.


